LETTER OF NOTIFICATION

Dear Ray:

On November 28, 2012 Jemez District Range personnel counted 10 head of your livestock within the Peralta Allotment between the Armijo private land and the V-Double Slash/Peralta boundary. You were notified immediately by telephone the location of these cattle and were given 3 days in which to remove them from the area. Unfortunately this was not the first instance in which you were notified to remove your cattle from the area.

Part 1 Section 8(d) of your permit states:

"The permittee will allow only the numbers, kind, and class of livestock on the allotment during the period specified in Part 1 hereof or the annual Bill for Collection, including any modifications made as provided for in Section 8(c). If livestock owned by the permittee are found to be grazing on the allotment in greater numbers, or at times or places other than permitted in part 1 hereof, or specified on the annual Bill for Collection, the permittee shall be billed for excess use at the unauthorized use rate and may face suspension or cancellation of this permit."

We do recognize the need to restore the allotment boundary fence, and will continue to work through the processes in order to have that fence restored. However, the 2012 V-Double Slash Annual Operating Instruction identifies that all permitted cattle will be moved to the Borrego and San Jose pastures by November 7, 2012. Therefore, there should no longer be any cattle on the northern pastures of the V-Double Slash allotment.

Please remove these cattle by December 1, 2012 and place them in the Borrego or San Jose pastures. An inspection will take place on December 3, 2012 to determine if you have complied with my instructions.
